My name is Musa Ecweru a Member of Parliament and a Minister of State for Relief, Disaster Preparedness and Refugees from Uganda.

Uganda is a former British Colony in East Africa; it got its independence in 1962. It sits in a very volatile region of Africa known as the Great Lakes Region.

It is also a few hours away by air from the countries that form what is known as the Horn of Africa.

It is a region characterized by fragile states and in some cases totally failed states.

Uganda has had its share of both man made and natural calamities and most of the man made are as a result of attempts to expand

radical Islam down south along the mighty Nile River particularly from Khartoum in the Sudan.

It is worth noting that from 1971 to 1979 an illiterate President in the names of Gen Idi Amin ruled the country with an iron fist dismantling all democratic institutions, murdering and exiling a number of academicians and suppressing all other religions denominations except Islam.

The consequences of Dictator Amin's rule and the scars he created are still being healed todate.

The motto of my country is "FOR GOD AND MY COUNTRY" and the Government that I represent today tries to aspire to the calling of our motto.

The NRM (National Resistant Movement) Government tries to strengthen the 3 arms of Governments; The Executive; The Judiciary and Legislature. Civil Society organizations and faith based organizations work closely with the media as the 4th estate playing a complementary role in the development of the country.

It is clear today that any society or country however strong economically or militarily, if it is morally weak is doomed.

Hence the need not only for freedom of worship but for active participation of faith based organizations in the day to day affairs of the country/society.
