

## Dr. Jorge Santos Brito

Jorge Manuel Sousa Santos Brito has a degree in Chemistry for Research from the University of Nice-France, a Master of Pedagogy from the University of Paris VII, France, and a PhD in Soil Science and Water (with a secondary strand in Chemistry from the University of Arizona – USA. He was the head of the Department of Natural Resources of the National Institute of Education in Praia, Cape Verde.
